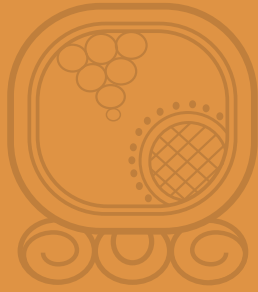

What about Guatemala?

Guatemala produces some of the finest coffee in the world. Although the fair-trade and organic coffee industries have helped some indigenous farmers, access to health care and basic infrastructure continues to be a problem.



Chocolá is a coffee-producing community of 15,000 inhabitants in the southern Piedmont of Guatemala. Wuqu' Kawoq has been working here for a number of years to provide health care and clean water technology to coffee workers and their families.

Clean Water

We use BioSand Filter technology to install long-lived (10 years) water filters in each home.

Child Malnutrition

We develop community-based health solutions, with a special focus on child malnutrition.

Rates of chronic malnutrition in the region are nearly 80%. However, with a combination of education, growth screening, and food supplementation, the problem can be solved!
